

Food and Drink Policy

The Red Bud Public Library strives to create a welcoming, clean, and comfortable environment for Library patrons, users, and community members to enjoy. Food and drink pose a risk to Library collections, equipment, carpeting, and furnishings. As such, food and drink are allowed within the Library on a presumed basis, following the regulations below.

Regulations

1. Alcohol is not allowed inside the Library and is strictly prohibited.
2. Water bottles and other closed-containers are allowed inside the Library; no open-container drinks.
3. No food is allowed in the Library unless with the express consent of the Library Director or the Assistant Librarian.
4. No food or drink is allowed at the computer work stations.
5. Food and drink are not to be left unattended or unsupervised.
6. Food and drink are not allowed within the bookshelf aisles. Food and drink should be kept strictly to the tables.
7. Individuals are responsible for cleaning up after themselves, throwing away all trash.
8. Spills are to be reported immediately to the Library staff.

Shall any of the above regulations become in violation by an individual, one warning will be issued by Library staff. Any repeated warnings may result in the individual being asked to leave the Library.
